4. Mrs.Nagina-UG coordinator


The committee has decided to forward the issue to local police station . However as Mr.Palden doesn't want proceed the incident as per anti-ragging law, it was decided to call all the students involved in the incident to college on 14/05/2018 for discussion.


On 14/05/2018 the committee has gathered together to discuss the further procedures.

Mr.TseringTenzin( Mysore Tibetan Student Association President) was also present during the discussion. He requested the college authority to not to proceed the incident legally and to solve the issue with in the college.

On Mr.Tsering Tenzin request it was decided by the committee that the incident will be resolved within the college. Mr Sourabh,Mr.Tajasvi&Mr . Chandan MR were asked tom write apology letter and submit to college. It was also informed to them that any such incidents in future will not be tolerated and serious actions will be taken. On that night, they keep calling me and threatening me to sign some papers. I couldn't sleep properly at that whole night.


On May 9 Wednesday

He was yelling at me in class in kannada language which I didn't understand at all then I asked him to speak in English but he replied me in slang word then I replied him with the same.

The very NEXT DAY; 8th May, afternoon around 1 pm me and my friend named Lekshey were on bike and was going for a lunch. All of sudden, Sourabh and his friends followed me and then suddenly they someone punched so hard on my face and i was realised it was Saurab and his gang who had planned to do so. I stopped my bike and defended myself and My friend who got injured too tried to stop the fight. They called two of their friends again and four of them had already plotted to beat me alone as they planned. They attacked me and I did my best to defence myself.

1. Sourav
2. Tejas
3. Chandan and
4. one local(unknown)

I called up one of my tibetan senior and told him everything. But he advised me to apologise those guys despite the fact that they attempted to Gang beating me. so we went to them and I beg them and I apologize to them but they were asking a sum of rupees 10000 and they even threaten me saying they will take me to court and will give complain to police. They continuously asking for money as blackmail. when I said I don't have money they even threatened me to sell my bike. I was too disturbed and felt very unsafe in Mysore. But still, I was trying to solve this problems by negotiate them of giving Rs 3000 or 8000 but they refused.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE ENQUIRY FOR THE  
INCIDENT OF SHERIN SIBY - III BPT - FOR  
LOST & FOUND PHONE.

There was a missing complaint regarding a mobile phone in Sept 2016 from library by Miss Sherin Siby who was in II BPT. The student was in library in the morning session around 9 am when she was called to the electro therapy lab. for practical class. The student was in hurry and forgot to take her phone which while she was signing out in the register. The student rushed to her class and forgot about the mobile. After class the student remembered that her phone was missing and she remembered that it could be in the library.

So she went immediately after the class to the library at 12:30 pm to find her phone. Ms. Savithri was the person on that day was at the counter. Sherin asked her about her phone that she had kept it over the counter & had forgotten to

take it while going to the class.  
For which she replied in a rude  
manner that she is not aware about  
any phone over the counter as she  
has seen any phone...

On 10/1/2017, at around 2 pm the  
student Shein along with her friends  
was returning to the college from hostel.  
She saw Mrs Sarithi along with  
Kamelamma (Peon) who was talking over  
the phone. The student immediately  
recognised her phone as she had a  
strong doubt on Sarithi at the time  
of the phone which had gone missing  
she saw that the screen of phone was  
broken which had happened one month  
before the phone was lost.

Shein identified and confirmed  
that it was her phone and confirmed  
to give back her phone. For which  
Sarithi told her that she had put her  
SIM card and would take it off and return  
the phone to Shein.  
Shein called to her native and  
asked her mother about IMEI number  
which was there on the box which was  
(357067061931141  
357067061931158.



similar to the phone which she had got from Sarithi.

As the student did not know much about Kunnada, she asked her classmate Mr. Pooriah to ask Sarithi regarding where she got the phone. Sarithi told him that she got the phone from a tunnel in front of the main door <sup>of the college</sup> 4 months ago, and she had taken it. She spoke in a very loud and rude manner to the students that she is not a thief and she has nothing to do with the phone.

Following this the student therein lodged a complaint that such an incident has happened in the Campus and she brought it to the notice of the Principal on 10/11/2017.

A committee was formed the next day on 11/11/2017 constituting of the following members to enquire about the whole incident.

Mr. Aditi Bhandinval - Asst Prof  
Office Co-ordinator  
Mrs. Geetha - Clerk SDA  
Mrs. Lemka - Attender.

Both of them were called individually and an enquiry was done over the incident.

Mrs. Saritha informed that she had found the phone 6 months ago in a trench at main door of the college (within the campus) and she had taken it.

She informed that in case of such matter she would not have brought it to college and would have used it for personal gains; she regularly brought the phone to college from the time she got the phone and was using it regularly.

On 10/1/2017 when the student Sheela saw her speaking over the phone & identified it as her phone she gave it to her after removing her (Saritha) SIM Card.

The enquiry committee heard from both parties regarding the incident and has taken following measures -

- 1) Advised the student to take care of their belongings and ~~not~~ to keep their expensive gadgets safely.
- 2) The peon has been informed that if she/he finds any such gadgets or any other things found in the campus should be handed over to the office or bring it to the notice of the Principal.
- 3) If such incidents occur strict action will be taken against the offenders.
