

Admission Procedure to BPT and MPT programs

Bachelors of Physiotherapy (BPT) Admission procedure

STEP 1 – REGISTRATION

- The registration process starts with candidate **applying** to the required course (BPT or MPT). This aids in communicating with you and guide you to application process
- Without application the institute will not be able to process the registration towards admission.
- The institute thoroughly scrutinizes the application for eligibility and other requirements necessary for admission to JSSCPT and RGUHS

STEP 2 – SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

- Can be done **Online or Physical (visiting the college in person)**

Online procedure

- Visit our college website (<https://jssphysiotherapy.edu.in/>)
- [Download the application](#)
- Fill the application in PDF or as hard copy
- Submit the filled application through email to admission_jsscpt@jssonline.org
- Supporting documents must be submitted along with the application, if not the application cannot be progressed.
- Student and parent's Aadhar card xerox must be submitted along with the application

Physical (visiting the college in person)

- Take a print out of the application
- Fill the application and add the supporting documents
- Send the application by registered / speed post to the college address as mentioned in the website OR visit the college and submit the application to the admission section at office.

STEP 3 – ANNOUNCEMENT OF SELECTION LIST

- After thorough scrutiny and eligibility of the application, the candidate will be selected based on the performance in the previous years
- The admission list will be announced with the last date for submission of original records and payment of fess
- Incase of MPT the students will be interviewed in person and the confirmation will be sent through the registered email.

STEP 4 – ADMISSION

The admission is confirmed based on following

- Admission validation and approval by the principal
- Once approved full fees are to be paid in the account section
- Admission will be confirmed only after submitting the original document and full fee payment.

PLEASE NOTE

- No other amount other than prescribed fees should be paid.
- All payments pertaining to admission and fees will be mandatorily issued a receipt (in case of online, once the cheque or transaction is realized)
- Non-Karnataka and CBSE students must take an eligibility certificate from the RGUHS university
- The college **DOES NOT** ask for any service charges, university charges & admission charges.
- The college adheres to Green Policy and encourages online submission and communications. Please be connected through email / phone and submit the email id which is working and frequently visited. If any changes please bring it to notice of the office
