With the mutual desire to **JSS COLLEGE OF PHYSIOTHERAPY**,M.G.Road,Mysuru-570004 (first party) and the **BCF COLLEGE OF PHYSIOTHERAPY**, Chemmanakary, Akkarapadom P.O, Vaikom, Kottayam , Kerala (second party) both the parties enter the formal statement of collaboration in the form of Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the purpose of academic, research , clinical and community outreach programs.

JSS COLLEGE OF PHYSIOTHERAPY,M.G.Road,Mysuru-570004 is represented by its Principal and the **JSS College of Physiotherapy**, M.G. Road, Mysuru, is a premier institute with the mandate of carrying out graduate, post-graduate Teaching and Research in the areas of Physiotherapy and has also built – in advanced laboratories for carrying out research activities, herein after called the **JSSCPT**, M.G. Road, Mysuru.

THE BAHULEYAN CHARITABLE FOUNDATION , COLLEGE OF PHYSIOTHERAPY, Chemmanakary, Akkarapadom P.O, Vaikom, Kottayam , Kerala hereinafter called as the **BCF COLLEGE OF PHYSIOTHERAPY** , represented by its head,, a one of the premier college in the Kerala which is attached with Super speciality Indo – American hospital, Brain and spine centre serving people with neurological disorders . **BCF College of Physiotherapy** also provides specialised care to neurological patients.

GOAL

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) establishes a cooperative relationship between the **JSS College of Physiotherapy, Mysore** and **THE BAHULEYAN CHARITABLE FOUNDATION, COLLEGE OF PHYSIOTHERAPY**, Chemmanakary, Akkarapadom P.O, Vaikom, Kottayam , Kerala

Under this MOU, **JSSCPT, Mysore** and **BCF College of Physiotherapy**, Chemmanakary, Akkarapadom P.O, Vaikom, Kottayam, Kerala will establish mutually beneficial links with the aim of establishing a specialized learning program for the students and faculty at campus for conducting and promoting academic, clinical, research and community outreach programs.

Following are the terms of the MoU

1. The **BCF COLLEGE OF PHYSIOTHERAPY**, Chemmanakary, Akkarapadam P.O, Vaikom, Kottayam , Kerala will facilitate the following
 - I. The BCF College of physiotherapy, Kottayam, Kerala will extend clinical postings in their hospitals, for undergraduate and post-graduate students of JSSCPT.
 - II. The BCF College of physiotherapy, Kottayam, Kerala shall support the JSSCPT, Mysuru in the specific disciplines/divisions/departments as a centre for collaborating in the research activities.
 - III. The BCF College of physiotherapy, Kottayam, Kerala shall extend the facilities available (clinical, outreach programs, library, etc.) for conducting research work by the students and faculty of JSSCPT, Mysuru.
 - IV. The BCF College of physiotherapy, Kottayam, Kerala will extend teaching undergraduate and post-graduate students in the specialization of Physiotherapy..
2. The **JSSCPT, Mysuru** will facilitate the following
 - I. Staff, Medical Social Workers, Faculty, graduates, post-graduate, of BCF College of physiotherapy, Kottayam, Kerala will be allowed to carry out their research work in the JSSCPT, Mysuru.
 - II. Make available the existing facilities like laboratory, library etc. at the JSSCPT, Mysuru to the faculty and students for the approved project work.
 - III. The JSSCPT, Mysuru will extend short term courses on Physiotherapy for the faculty and students of BCF College of physiotherapy, Kottayam, Kerala.
 - IV. The JSSCPT, Mysuru will extend clinical postings in department of Physiotherapy, JSS hospital, Mysore and physical medicine and rehabilitation centre.
3. **General**
 - I. Benefits such as improved technology, materials, machinery, process, designs and techniques, accruing or arising from this cooperative effort may be used by either or both the parties with due recognition of each party's contribution.
 - II. Results from collaborative research may be used by either or both the parties with due recognition of each party's contribution.

- III. Research findings as a result of this collaborative work of both the parties will be published in the public interest.
- IV. Research findings published by either party will give credit to others party's contribution, but the party publishing them will be entirely responsible for conclusions and interpretations reported.
- V. Workshops, conferences, and mutual benefit programs may be carried out with initiatives taken by either of the institution, which may work together for knowledge enrichment.

This agreement will be in effect initially for a period 5 years from the date of signing of this MOU by both the party's, renewable further if mutually agreed. Either party may terminate the agreement by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the institution initiating the notice. Such notice must be received by the other party six months prior to the effective termination date. However, obligations and commitments already contracted for and involving their parties shall be honoured and continued by both parties until such commitments are completed.
