Resolution of the last Governing Council Meeting Held on 31-09-2011

5.02 1. Awareness campaign program of back, knee and neck pain for the staffs and the faculty in the hospital as suggested by the Executive Secretary.

Action taken

Principal of JSS college of physiotherapy Dr. Mruthyunjaya suggested to do this program on staff nurse and medical professionals. Preliminary work has been done and the brochure/handouts, required to educate staff has been prepared by our faculties. Execution of this program will be done shortly within two months.- Annexure- I

Suggestion:

Dr. Basavanne gowda principal of J.S.S. Medical college appreciated and added suggestion to Dr. Mruthyunjaya principal of J.S.S. college of physiotherapy on topic awareness campaign program of health as follows;

- 1} should be focused on conducting special camp together with Orthopedic department, community medicine and other department of health sciences
- 2} Staff should be emphasized on writing an article related to physiotherapy treatment in NEWS paper.
- 3} staff should be emphasized to give talk on physiotherapy treatment in radio, Television. The Governing body agreed suggestion given by Dr. Basavanne Gowda and Governing council members of physiotherapy college assured that the above programs will be conducted shortly.

Action taken

The proposed plan of JSS REHABILATION CENTRE was discussed with the Executive Secretary. It has been suggested to modify the existing quadrangle of CT scan, MRI Laboratory and old special ward for the purpose. The plan has been prepared in discussion with all the staff of Physiotherapy & Occupational therapy. The blue print of the Rehab Centre is ready- Annexure- II

Suggestion: In this regard Dr. Basavanne Gowda, principal of J.S.S. Medical college made a debate on practical feasibility having physiotherapy department both in new hospital as well as in upcoming Rehabilitation Center. Advantages and Disadvantage on this topic was discussed, yet the decisions to be finalized.

3. Posting of post graduates and house surgeons to Vivekananda memorial hospital at Sargur, as suggested by the Executive Secretary.

Action taken

The matter has been discussed with Dr.Seetharam.M.R, consultant Orthopedic surgeon and Head of Health Activities, S.V.Y.M, Sargur. He has requested us to post a team of two persons at a time for a period of one to two months,. He has offered to arrange for their stay in the hospital premises. Annexure -III

Suggestion

In this regard Dr Mruthyunjaya and Mr. Mahesh, Medical Director Proposed to send 2 persons (Post graduate students and interns) for 15 days on Rotation basis.

1. Free treatment for staff.

Action taken

JSS MVP had circulated the Health insurance Scheme and had suggested our staff also to be included in the same. The Circular was brought to the notice of all the staff members and offered them to join . But all staff members were not willing for the proposal as they had already made their own health policies.
