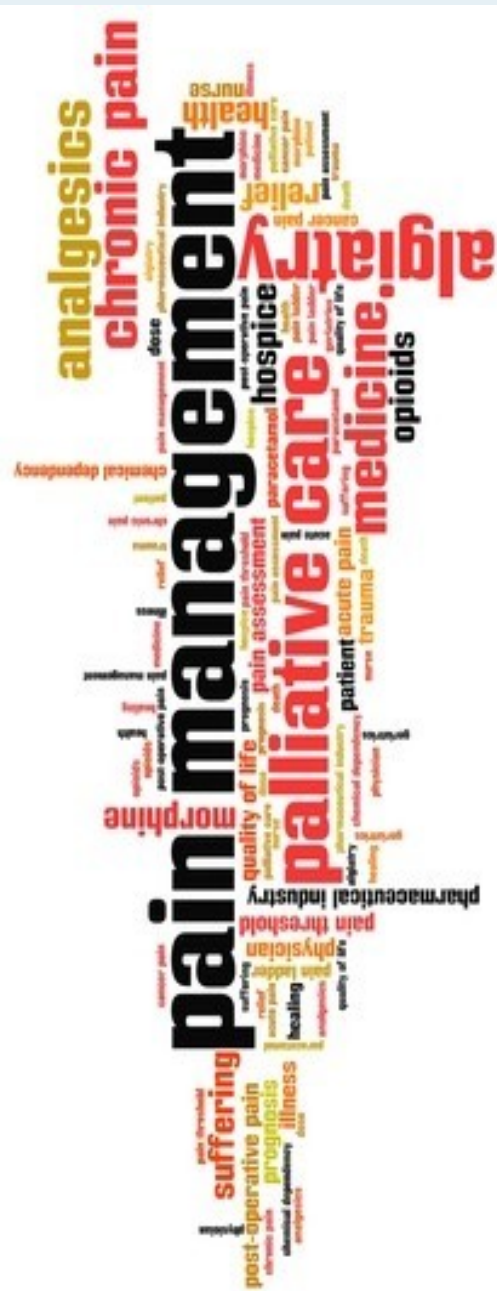

- Only E-posters will be allowed

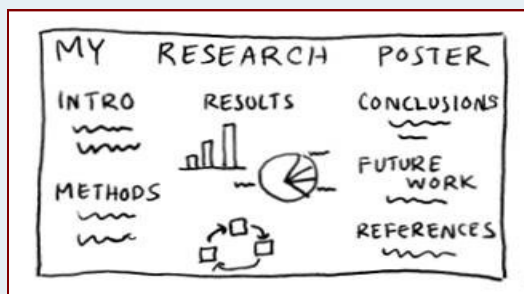
