MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

JSS COLLEGE OF PHYSIOTHERAPY, M.G.ROAD, MYSURU FOR FACILITATING

COLLABORATIVE TRAINING AND POST GRADUATE RESEARCH

With the mutual desire, **Jagadguru Sri Shivaratheeshwarar University (JSSU)**, Sri Shivarathreeshwara Nagara, Mysuru-570015 (first party) and the **JSS College of Physiotherapy**, M.G.Road, Mysuru-570004 (second party) enter into the formal statement of collaboration in the form of Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the purpose of academic and research interaction and collaboration.

Jagadguru Sri Shivaratheeshwara University, Mysuru hereinafter called as the JSSU, Mysuru and represented by its Registrar and the JSS College of Physiotherapy, M.G.Road, Mysuru, hereinafter called JSSCPT, Mysuru, a premier institute with the mandate of carrying out Graduate, Post-graduate Teaching and Research in the areas of Physiotherapy and has also built in advanced laboratories for carrying out research activities and represented by its Principal.

Following are the terms of the MOU

1. The JSSU, Mysuru will facilitate the following

- I. The JSSU, Mysuru shall support the JSSCPT, Mysuru in the specific disciplines/divisions/departments as a center for collaborating the research leading to the award of Ph.D. degree in accordance with Rule'9' of the Ph.D.Regulations-2012 of JSSU, Mysuru. The Ph.D Regulations of JSSU, Mysuru shall be construed as final in any dispute regarding awarding Ph.D Degree.
- II. The eligible full-time faculty members of the JSSCPT, Mysuru on their individual merits and in accordance with the University Ph.D Regulations-2012 shall be recognized as co-guides for guiding research programme of the students.
- III. The JSSU, Mysuru shall extend the facilities available with its constituent colleges and University Departments (laboratories, library, etc.) for conducting research work by the registered scholars of JSSCPT, Mysuru.
- IV. The candidate shall bear the application, registration, examination and tuition fees as per the University norms. The candidate shall also bear the cost of consumables for their research work payable to the respective colleges where their research work is carried out.

2. The JSSCPT, Mysuru will facilitate the following

- I. Post-graduate, students registering for Ph.D with JSSU, Mysuru will be allowed to carry out their research work in the JSSCPT, Mysuru as per Rule 9 of the JSSU, Mysuru Ph.D Regulations- 2012.
- II. Make available the existing facilities like laboratory, library etc. at the JSSCPT, Mysuru to the students for the approved project/research work.

3. General

- I. The course structure, fee and all academic procedures shall have to be according to the Regulations for the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.d.) 2012 of JSSU.
- II. Benefits such as improved technology, materials, machinery, process, designs and techniques, accruing or arising from this cooperative effort may be used by either or both the parties with due recognition of each party's contribution.

- III. Results from collaborative research may be used by either or both the parties with due recognition of each party's contribution.
- IV. Research findings as a result of this collaborative work of both the parties will be published in the public interest.
- V. Research findings published by either party will give credit to others party's contribution, but the party publishing them will be entirely responsible for conclusions and interpretations reported and follow the Publication Policy of JSSU.
- VI. Research findings as a result of this collaborative work of both the parties will be subjected to filing patent and commercialization and technology transfer with respect to Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) in the interest of the researcher, JSSU and JSSCPT by following Patent & Innovation Policy of JSSU.
- VII. In the absence of any specific procedure in the MOU; the university regulations 2012 shall be made applicable.
- VIII. In case of ambiguity in the MOU, the Regulations for the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.d.) 2012 of JSSU shall be construed as final.

This agreement will be in effect initially for a period 5 years from the date of signing of this MOU by both the parties, renewable further if mutually agreed. Either party may terminate the agreement by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the institution initiating the notice. Such notice must be received by the other party six months prior to the effective termination date. However, obligations and commitments already contracted for and involving their parties shall be honoured and continued by both parties until such commitments are completed.
