

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

FOR FACILITATING
COLLABORATIVE ACADEMICS AND RESEARCH

With the mutual desire to **JSS Ayurvedic Medical College**, # 41/ E, Lalithadripura Road, Mysuru, Karnataka 570028 and the **JSS College of Physiotherapy**, M. G. Road, Mysuru-570004 both the college enter the formal statement of collaboration in the form of Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the purpose of academic and research interaction.

JSS Ayurvedic Medical College, Mysuru herein after called as the **JSSAMC**, Mysuru, represented by its Principal and the **JSS College of Physiotherapy**, M.G. Road, Mysuru, is a premier institute with the mandate of carrying out graduate, post-graduate Teaching and Research in the areas of Physiotherapy and has also built – in advanced laboratories for carrying out research activities, herein after called the **JSSCPT**, M.G. Road, Mysuru and represented by its Principal.

Following are the terms of the MoU

1. The **JSSAMC, Mysuru** will facilitate the following
 - I. The JSSAMC, Mysuru shall support the JSSCPT, Mysuru in the specific disciplines/divisions/departments as a centre for collaborating in the research activities.
 - II. The JSSAMC, Mysuru shall extend the facilities available (laboratories, library, etc.) for conducting research work by the faculty and departments of JSSCPT, Mysuru.
 - III. The JSSAMC, will extend short term courses on Yoga, Naturopathy, Ayurveda, Diet, and nutrition.
 - IV. The JSSAMC, will extend teaching undergraduate and post-graduate students in subjects of Yoga, Naturopathy, Ayurveda, Diet, and nutrition.
 - V. The JSSAMC, will extend clinical postings in JSS Ayurveda hospital, for undergraduate and post-graduate students of JSSCPT.

2. The **JSSCPT, Mysuru** will facilitate the following
 - I. Faculty, graduates, post-graduate, of JSSAMC will be allowed to carry out their research work in the JSSCPT, Mysuru.
 - II. Make available the existing facilities like laboratory, library etc. at the JSSCPT, Mysuru to the faculty and students for the approved project work.
 - III. The JSSCPT, will extend short term courses on Physiotherapy for the faculty and students of JSSAMC.
 - IV. The JSSCPT will extend teaching undergraduate and post-graduate students in physiotherapy subjects related to curriculum of JSSAMC.
 - V. The JSSCPT will extend clinical postings in physical medicine and rehabilitation centre, for post-graduate (Panchakarma) students of JSSAMC.

3. General

- I. Benefits such as improved technology, materials, machinery, process, designs and techniques, accruing or arising from this cooperative effort may be used by either or both the parties with due recognition of each party's contribution.
- II. Results from collaborative research may be used by either or both the parties with due recognition of each party's contribution.
- III. Research findings as a result of this collaborative work of both the parties will be published in the public interest.
- IV. Research findings published by either party will give credit to others party's contribution, but the party publishing them will be entirely responsible for conclusions and interpretations reported.
- V. Workshops, conferences, and mutual benefit programs may be carried out with initiatives taken by either of the institution, which may work together for knowledge enrichment.
- VI. Collaborative short-term courses may be planned in ordinance with JSSAMC and JSSCPT.

Confidentiality

The JSS Ayurveda Medical College and JSS College of physiotherapy agree to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the institutes as being confidential which is obtained from either institutions or created during the performance of MOU will not disclosed the same to any third party without return consent of the other institute.

The above mentioned confidential clause under this MOU excludes the information/data possessed by either institute before entering into MOU at independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

Intellectual property rights

Intellectual property rights (IPR) that arises as a result of joint research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case to case basis and will be consistant with official laid down IPR policies of the two institutes.


This agreement will be in effect initially for a period 5 years from the date of signing of this MOU by both the party's, renewable further if mutually agreed. Either party may terminate

the agreement by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the institution initiating the notice. Such notice must be received by the other party six months prior to the effective termination date. However, obligations and commitments already contracted for and involving their parties shall be honoured and continued by both parties until such commitments are completed.
