YEAR 2013-14

Parent teachers' meeting was held for the 1st year BPT students on 9th May 2013, after the 1st and 2nd internal assessment exam, to inform the parents on the academic performance of their wards. 17 of the 40 parents attended and were happy that the college takes such an initiative of making the parents aware of their children's academic progress in the professional course. Those who couldn't come on that day met the class coordinator the coming week, and a few who were not in a position to come were informed about their wards' performance through telephone.

Some of them gave a suggestion of individual attention to those students who have difficulty in coping with the difficult subjects and, this was taken up in the review meeting held at the end of the academic year.

YEAR 2014-15

The parent teachers' meeting was held for the 1st and 2nd BPT students on 16th January 2015, soon after the 1st internal assessment exam. Academic performance and shortage of attendance of the students were informed to the parents, and they were made to sign an undertaking that those who would have attendance shortage or do not get the required minimum 50% marks in the final internal marks would not be eligible to appear for the university exam.

There was a request by the students and parents to conduct more of practical classes so that they could get more of practice sessions before the exams.

YEAR 2015-16

In this academic year, meeting was held for the parents of students of all the four years of BPT classes, held on 18th January 2016. The performance of the students in the 1st internal assessment exam was discussed with the parents, apart from the attendance.

An undertaking was taken from the parents that they were aware of the requirements in attendance and internal assessment marks to be eligible to appear for the university exam. Contact numbers and mail ids of all the parents were taken. Some parents who couldn't attend on that day contacted the coordinators and met in the coming two weeks.

YEAR 2016-17

The meeting was held for parents of all the four years of BPT classes on 22nd December 2016, soon after the 1st internal exam. Students' academic performance and attendance were discussed with the parents. 9 out of 20 parents of the final years attended the meeting while another 9 who could not make it on that day communicated with the coordinator and met later. 26 of the 56 parents of the 2nd BPT students were present; some of them who couldn't come on that day spoke with the coordinator on telephone.

Undertaking was signed by the parents regarding the prerequisites to be eligible to appear for the university exam. They were also told regarding the availability of remedial classes for slow learners/ poor performers, and those who were not interested in availing this facility were made to write that they were aware of the existence of this facility by the college, but were opting out.

The parents of one student of 2nd BPT, Miss Nissi Shiffali, who was very irregular to the classes were tried to be contacted by the office but since there was no response by telephone, information was sent through post on 27th February 2017 regarding the same. The student was not eligible to appear for the university exam due to shortage of attendance and was not allowed to appear.
