

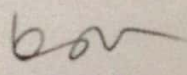
Problem Based Learning Report

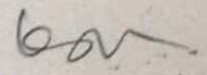
2016-17

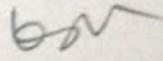

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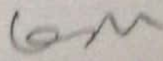
Soft Skills Development Report

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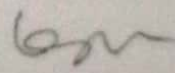
English Coaching Report

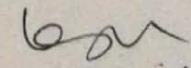
Sessions of 3 days / week total of 74 hours. The session were held on general practical examination of each student, physical fitness and fitness improvement.
