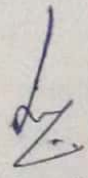

Our academic week and academic day will be conducting on April last week.

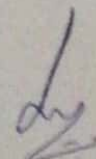
UG CON for the first time in JSS College of physiotherapy is one of our future goal to achieve. Which will be by the UG's and for the UG's.
