- Awareness to approach for Education and management for such persons

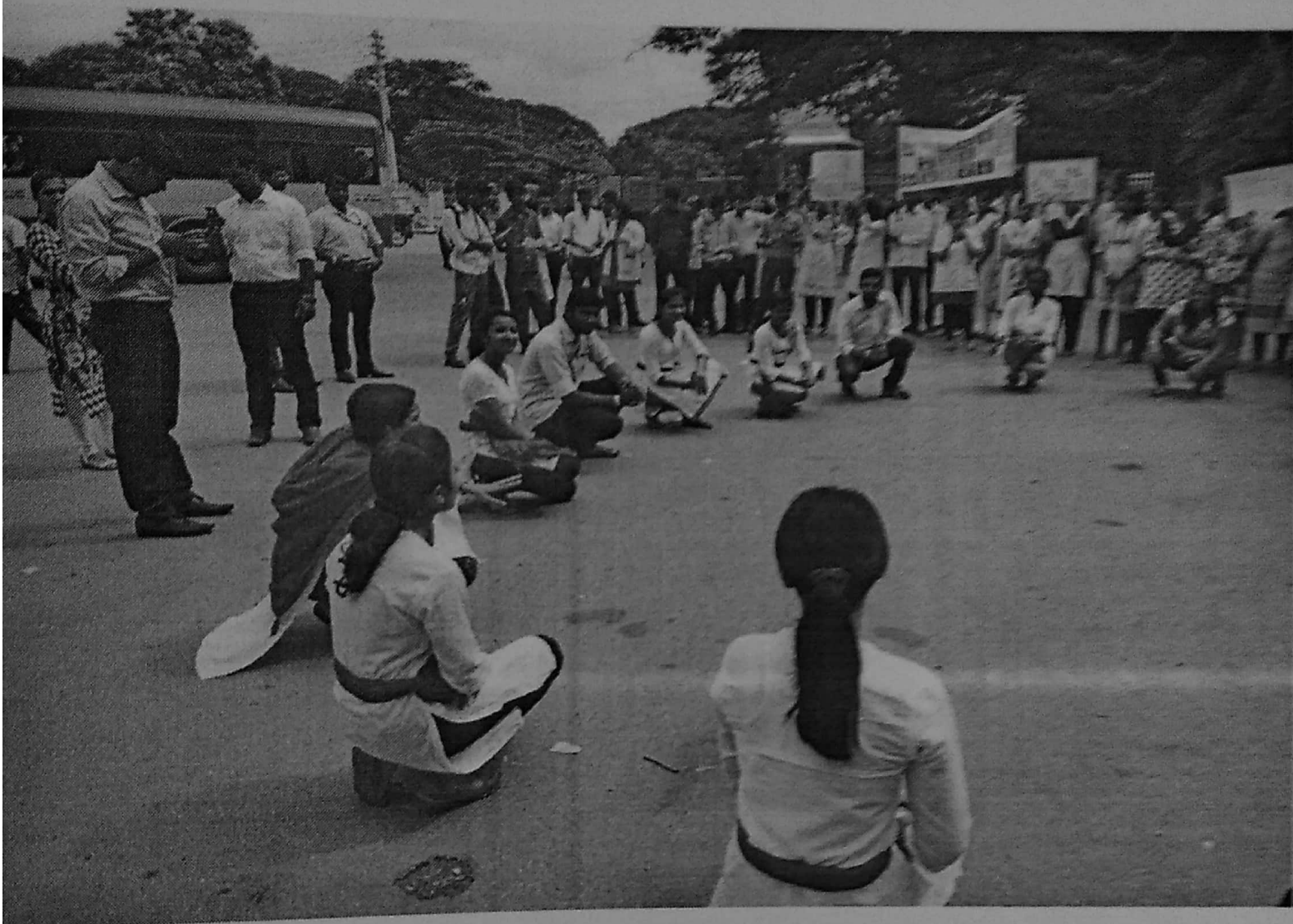

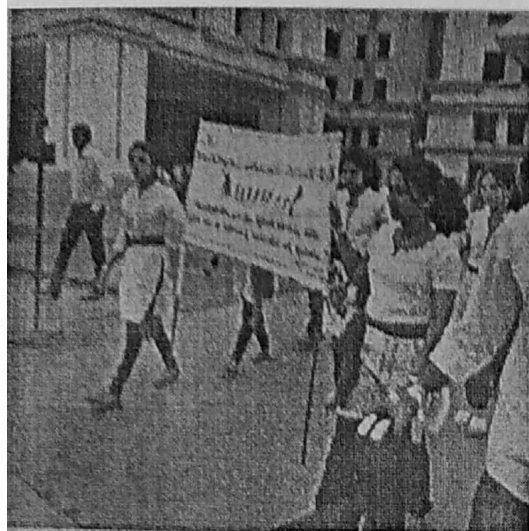
Our students included a disability related street play to create an awareness of disability issues in the public as well as to change the misperception about persons with disabilities.

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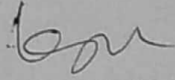
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JSS PMRC THERAPEUTIC OUTING REPORT – February 2018

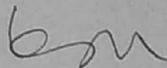

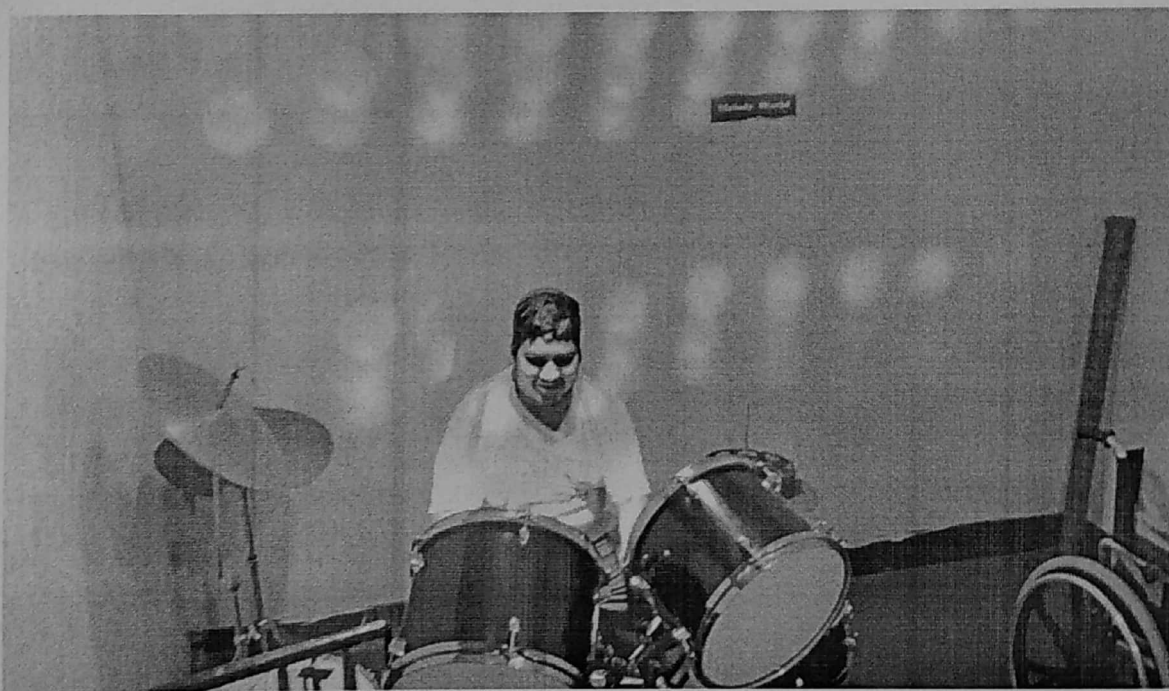

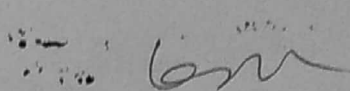


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JSS PMRC THERAPEUTIC OUTING REPORT – March 2017
